English as a Second Language (ESL) Courses for Adult Citizens, Permanent Residents, and Refugees

- Testing Hours: Monday through Thursday - 9:30 am to 6:30 pm; Fridays - 9:30 am to 5:00 pm;
Saturdays - 8:30 am to 2:30 pm. (closed on holiday weekends)
- Please bring your Permanent Resident Card, Citizenship card or Canadian passport, or your refugee papers.
- Classes are taught by volunteer teachers; classes are not for credit and do not transfer to other schools.
- The LEX Program is funded by the Government of Alberta, Ministry of Labour.
- Our classes have continuous enrollment. **MANY OF OUR CLASSES ARE FULL AND HAVE WAITING LISTS.**

GENERAL ESL CLASSES

Monday–Thursday
(4 days a week)

Mornings: 9 am - 12 pm

Afternoons: 1 pm - 4 pm

Nights: 6 pm - 8 pm

Classes start on January 9, 2017.

6 LEVELS:

Literacy, Low Beginner, Beginner, High Beginner, Low Intermediate, Intermediate
(There is no Low Beginner class 9 am – 12 pm, and no Intermediate class 1 pm – 4 pm)

Focus on reading, writing, listening, speaking, and grammar
(6 months /term: September – February; February – July)

Registration fee: \$30 Includes books and materials**
Class fee: \$30 / 4 weeks (Morning/ Afternoon)
\$20 / 4 weeks (Evening)

No class October 7 & November 11, 2017

Tuition: \$40/12 weeks

Registration: \$30

Registration opens August 8, 2017.

All Saturday classes have continuous enrollment; new students can join anytime. It takes two sessions to complete one level of study. The January 7, 2017 session starts from Unit 1.

**Students registering after the start date pay \$3.5/week. Students must register until the end of the session.*

**Registration is a one-time fee for new students and those returning after a 6-month break.*
